

W Footpaths

W1 — .. - Burgengratweg



An adventurous ramble from the ruined castle at Pfeffingen to the Klushof, on narrow paths (not suitable for prams or push-chairs) passing caves and mediaeval fortresses with many inviting barbeque areas.

W2 — — — Kunstweg



A cultural walk through Aesch. A leisurely and interesting walk on roads taking in the many easily accessible works of art. (Guide available from the local government centre).

W3 — . — . Stroll along the river Birs



A pleasant natural path along both sides of the river from Angenstein to Dornachbrugg, passing an interesting wooden bridge and peaceful spots ideal for picnics.

W4 — . — . Stroll along the Klusbach



A peaceful walk by the idyllic babbling brook passing two ponds and a small waterfall (beyond the Klushof). Benches invite you to sit and linger.

W5 — — — Vineyard Walk



A wonderful panorama walk through the middle of Aesch's vineyards, the largest in the county. Well constructed paths with notices giving interesting information about the vines and the vintners.
